In Ronchi di Percoto grappa celebrates culture

Tomorrow the Nonino Prize. With the Nobel laureates Naipaul and Higgs

A true guaranteed quality distillate of culture, the Nonino Prize had always represented one of the most illustrious and exclusive appointments if the international landscape. Also for its 39th edition it has gathered some of the most eminent representatives of literature, art, science and show business. Presided by V.S. Naipaul (Nobel Laureate in literature 2001) and composed by Ulderico Bernardi, Peter Brook, Fabiola Gianotti, Claudio Magris, Edgar Morin and Ermanno Olmi among the others, this year the jury of the Prize has awarded the Palestinian writer and architect Suad Amiry, the Portuguese novelist António Lobo Antunes, the psychiatrist and writer Giuseppe Dell'Acqua, and the French philosopher and literate Michel Serres. The awarding ceremony will take place on Saturday 25th January at the Nonino Distilleries in Ronchi di Percoto, in the province of Udine; and after a toast in honor of Peter Higgs – Nobel laureate in Physics 2013 – the celebration will finish with a lunch and final dance, strictly accompanied by the tasting of Cru Monovitigno Picolit.
